Continuing Business

- <u>Nominating Committee Report</u>: Only the Outreach Chair position remains to be filled. One of Bridget's goals for Common Ministry for 2023 is every Ministry working to "tithe" new membership within the team by getting at least one new person on each Ministry every year.
- <u>Capital Campaign Feasibility Study Recommendation</u>: Tim distributed the summary recommendation. Motion to recommend presentation of the Capital Campaign proposal for a vote at the Annual Meeting was approved (Achim/Betty).
- <u>2023 Budget:</u> Sandy distributed a proposed budget for discussion. A decision to recommend a budget for the Annual Meeting will be presented at the January meeting.

Proposed Union Congregational UCC Bylaw Changes

 Article II Section 1: This is a correction changing the reference from Section 22 to 21. The Pastor, with consultation with the Personnel Committee and with privilege of consultation with any appropriate Officer, Ministry, or the Common Ministry, will engage or discharge, when necessary, all paid church personnel including (but not limited to) all Assistant Pastors, pastoral, program, music, administrative, financial and secretarial staff, sextons and housekeepers, with the exception of Associate Pastors; subject to Section 22-22 (Common Ministry approves salaries).

Rationale: Correction

Article II Section 21: This change gives Vice-Chairs the right to represent their Ministry at Common Ministry in the absence of the Chair.

The Common Ministry shall consist of the Pastors, other members of the pastoral staff, the Chairpersons of each Ministry or in their absence the Vice-Chair of such Ministry, the Moderator (who chairs the Ministry), the Vice Moderator, the Clerk and the Treasurer.

Rationale: It has been a common practice at Union for the Vice-Chairs to represent their ministry in the absence of the Chair, especially if they view themselves functioning as co-chairs. This memorializes the current practice.

3. Article III Section 22: Creates a mechanism to fill Officer vacancies.

The Nominating Committee shall <u>recommend for approval of Common Ministry</u>, individuals for Chair. <u>Vice Chair</u>, or Officer fill by appointment Chair or Vice Chair, vacancies that occur at times other than the expiration of a term.

Rationale: The Bylaws provide for The Nominating Committee to fill Chair or Vice-Chair vacancies, but not Officer vacancies. This change allows for Chair, Vice-Chair and Officer vacancies to be filled by recommendation of the Nominating Committee to Common Ministry before the next Annual meeting.

4. Article II Section 25: Adds a new section for Indemnification of church leaders.

Section 25. Indemnification. The Church shall indemnify any person who is or was an employee, agent, representative, member of Common Ministry, or committee or task force authorized by Common Ministry against any liability asserted against such person and incurred in the course and scope of his or her duties or functions within the Church to the maximum extent allowable by law, provided the person did not engage in an act or omission that is intentional, willfully or wantonly nealigent, or done with conscious indifference or reckless disregard for the safety of others. The provisions of this article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which such person may be entitled under any bylaw. agreement, insurance policy, vote of members or otherwise.

Rationale: This section gives added protection to those involved in Union's Ministries. It is customary for organizations to include an indemnification clause in the organization's bylaws in addition to carrying indemnification insurance.
