JOSHUA Report: Steve reported on JOSHUA's summer activities, which included sponsoring a table at the We All Rise Juneteenth event, the mobile solitary confinement event, a prison doula project (in cooperation with FREE) dealing with women bearing children in prison, and an Art Garage project writing letters to people who are incarcerated. Congregational Joys and Concerns: Joys and concerns were shared.

Minister's Report: In addition to the work she undertakes with the various Ministries, Bridget reported that pastoral care has taken up a good amount of time this summer. Nursery is in need of additional staffing. In the meantime, Bridget may ask families who utilize the nursery share in the staffing as the 2nd adult. The person scheduled to facilitate the retreat is not going to be able to do it; Bridget will handle it. Parson's Purse is in need of funds. Funds go to many things, including hotel stays, gas cards, prescription copays, clothing items, etc. Last year there were also lots of requests for energy assistance. Thanks to Beth for helping to connect her with a person who will do ALICE (active shooter) training. CM discussed and determined that a Sunday after worship would be best to hold the training. Clay volunteered to write a Friday email article in September.

Clerk's Report

Treasurer's Report

Sandy distributed the regular financial reports for July (attached). June income was higher than anticipated. Things are pretty stable. Capital campaign accounting is taking some time, so Katrina's hours may be a little bit higher. Accepted (Jammie/Denise).

Sandy added a report on the Killoran Scholarship. She reported on the students who are receiving scholarship funds. We have now given away more than the original principal. Committee members include Sandy, Mary Garber, Kris Vespia, Jeff Zahn, Betty Bienash, and Heather Collins.

Continuing Business

• <u>Capital Campaign Update:</u> Capital Campaign is going strong. As of the end of July, \$568,000 has been pledged, and \$108,000 received after paying for the new door, and not including the gift from Gifts & Memorials (funds to pay the James Co). 19% of pledges have come in, which the James Company would consider quite healthy.

Stewardship moved approval to expend funds for three critical Capital Campaign projects as follows:

- Up to \$75,000 for the church hall roof project
- Up to \$35,000 for the elevator repair and other critical elevator maintenance projects
- Up to \$16,000 for tuckpointing

The request was approved (Second Beth).

• Generosity Team Update: The Team has been very busy working on the annual pledge campaign. The campaign will have a brochure, and rather than the usual testimonials, will have 5 events after worship with the theme, "A Season of Love in Action":
