- 3. Up to \$20,000 for updated Wi-Fi equipment, which will be professionally installed.

JOSHUA has joined FREE To improve treatment at health conditions for women who are pregnant and in prison. A revision of the bylaws for JOSHUA are being completed. Finally, JOSHUA is encouraging Christmas cards be sent to currently incarcerated people. This is an effort to lend a measure of humanity and encouragement and goodwill in a situation, which often feels desperate and despairing.
