HOW DOES WHAT WE AS COMMON MINISTRY ARE DOING AFFECT THE CHURCH'S RACIAL AND SOCIAL JUSTICE WORK?

Moderator Tim Harder called the meeting to order at 6:07 p.m.

Gathering Prayer: Clay shared a prayer.

Additions to the Agenda: None.

Congregational Joys and Concerns: Joys and concerns were shared.

Minister's Report: Bridget shared that she felt this Christmas was one of the best she's ever had—the music was delightful, there was a remarkable spirit of folks coming together and attendance was higher than the last pre-COVID year. She is among broad spectrum of folks who have been invited to participate in a training for a group focused on fair elections. Unfortunately, the training is on Ash Wednesday, so she is unsure about her ability to attend. She reported we have a new custodian, Brad Dorin. Has been diligent about snow removal and cleaning. Will be here Sunday mornings and then Monday-Thursday. Ray Thompson, our Organist, has given notice that he is resigning. February 11 will be his last Sunday. She and Haley have discussed next steps, which will include interim organists, some opportunities outside of worship to hear some music we don't often hear, listening opportunities, and a written survey. They plan to put together a team to do active listening in those offerings to then create a position description and hopefully post the position in March and interview in mid-to-late April. The intent is not to significantly change the focus of our music, but rather to do some tweaking, freshening, and maybe (or not) doing some things differently.

Clerk's Report

The minutes for the regular meeting of December 2023 were approved (Heather/Kathy). Gail reported that the following Gifts & Memorials motion was adopted by email vote:

Motion to approve a grant of up to \$2,250.00 for expenditures to support the 2024 MLK Day of Service, with reimbursement of expenses to be made to We All Rise upon presentation of appropriate evidence of expenditures made.

Gail noted that she will not be present for the March meeting, and that upon appointment as Clerk pro tem, Heather Collins has agreed to take minutes at that meeting. Gail read a thank you note from Eric Goska.

Treasurer's Report

Sandy distributed the regular financial reports for December (attached). She highlighted that December income was greater than expenditures and noted there was nothing out of the ordinary. We spent about \$13,000 more than we took in for the year and are left at year end with about \$8,000 in surplus. The report was accepted (Clay/Kathy).

New Business

• Annual Meeting – There will not be a Zoom alternative. The meeting will be January 28 right after the service. A potluck will follow with ham and rolls provided. Common Ministry will need help with setup and cleanup.

Continuing Business

- 2024 Budget Update: Sandy distributed the proposed 2024 budget (attached). After discussion, it was approved for presentation to the congregation at the Annual Meeting (Sandy/Denise).
- Generosity Team Update: A letter will be sent to folks who pledged in 2023 but who have not pledged for the 2024 budget. \$317,000 has been pledged to date. The team is working on an April campaign focusing on people who don't generally pledge.
- 2024 Nominating Committee Update: Sandy distributed a draft. Stewardship chair continues to be vacant.

GIFTS & MEMORIALS
