Minister's Report: Bridget will not be attending the gathering about disrupting political violence she mentioned in the January meeting. She has agreed to work with a religious studies class on black theology at St. Norberts which will involve 4-5 students embedded into the community for a semester. They will work with Bridget on church history, and attend worship. Their final project will be designed to help the congregation move forward on its anti-discrimination efforts. Bridget noted that the new sexton is working out wonderfully. With sadness, she reminded us that Ray's last day at the organ will be this coming Sunday. There will be a reception after church. The F Word project will be installed February 24. There will be a lunch-and-learn after the coffee hour on February 25. If anyone would be able to provide lodging to the curator of the exhibit on February 24, please let her know. The offerings for the Lenten movie series have been set. Beth agreed to write an article for the email newsletter one of the weeks in March.

Clerk's Report

Whereas, Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code permits a minister of the gospel to exclude from gross income (in computing federal income taxes) a church-designated allowance paid as part of their compensation to the extent it is used by for actual expenses in owning or renting a home; and Whereas, the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels is compensated by Union Congregational United Church of Christ exclusively for the services as a minister of the gospel; and

Whereas, Union Congregational United Church of Christ does not provide the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels with a parsonage, therefore, it is hereby resolved that:

- the total compensation for housing and salary paid to the Rev. Bridget Flad Daniels for calendar year 2023 shall be \$84,404 of which \$37,746 (45%) is hereby designated to be a housing allowance, and
- the designation of \$37,746 as a housing allowance shall apply to calendar year 2024 and all future years unless otherwise provided.

Pew shortening has gotten great feedback. Pew cushion shortening plans are underway.

WORSHIP

Most work has been Easter planning. F Word project will begin February 25. The Maundy Thursday service will be an Agape meal. Good Friday will be a Tenebrae service. There will be 2 services on Easter. April Communion date has been moved the second Sunday. Haley has applied for and received a campus ministry grant from the Wisconsin Conference, which will allow for 4 choir internships. A committee to work on Ray's successor has been established, and will include Tim, Zoe, Tracey Klickman, Emily Lakatos, Jade Hatton, Bridget, and Haley. There are plans for congregational input both in person and via a written survey, after which a position description will be developed. The hope is to begin interviewing in the spring. David Hassel and Elaine Moss will fill in through Easter.
