HOW DOES WHAT WE AS COMMON MINISTRY ARE DOING AFFECT THE CHURCH'S RACIAL AND SOCIAL JUSTICE WORK?

Moderator Tim Harder called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m.

Gathering Prayer: Zoe shared a prayer.

Agenda Additions: Heather was appointed as Clerk Pro-Tem. Tim provided an orientation to new members of Common Ministry.

Congregational Joys and Concerns: Joys and concerns were shared.

**Minister's Report:** Bridget reported that the F word installation was taken down yesterday. We had a pretty steady stream of visitors from all over NE WI. Bridget's black theology students will provide their proposals to her next week. Organist Search Advisory committee has met twice. The 2 listening sessions were moderately attended. Written survey to congregation expected to come out after Easter. The position is posted, resume deadline of April 15. Bridget asked if anyone would be interested in participating in a group to study and make recommendations about Indigenous Justice and Land Acknowledgements. Union will participate in JOSHUA's Big Read of "A More Perfect Union" by Adam Russell Taylor. Taylor has been invited to speak with us as a part of the Big Read.

## **New Business**

• <u>G&M Grant Request</u>:

• Gifts and Memorials recommends that \$20,000 be granted to the Wisconsin Conference for the Leadership Forward project with \$10,000 in 2024 and \$10,000 in 2025 coming from the distribution and donation line. Motion carried.

- Gifts and Memorials recommends that \$3,000 be used as a contingency fund for the remaining Spring 2025 program year of 4 music internships as a part of the college outreach program if 2025 funding is not secured from the WI Conference UCC. After that with \$8,000/program year through 2029 with the stipulation that the music director continually seeks outside funding for this project first. If needed, this money should come from the distribution and donation line. Motion carried.
- April 20 Association Meeting Delegate: Bridget and Tim seeking a volunteer to attend and represent Union.
- <u>Conference Annual Meeting at Green Lake June 6-8 Delegate</u>: Bridget and Tim seeking a volunteer to attend and represent Union
  - <u>Building Use Request</u>: Taylor Giorgio would like to hold recital at Union for 50 of her music students but does not have insurance. Motion to allow recital to be scheduled without Taylor providing insurance. (Sandy/Jammie)

• <u>Land Acknowledgement Study Group</u>: Motion to form a new study group on Indigenous justice and land acknowledgement. (Sandy/Zoe). Motion carried.

## **Continuing Business:**

• Generosity Team Update: Follow up of generosity program will take place in spring. Christmas in July type event and fundraiser.

• Capital Campaign: \$265.8 received which is 47% of pledges received. This is significantly greater than where the James Company projected we should be 7 months into campaign.
