HOW DOES WHAT WE AS COMMON MINISTRY ARE DOING AFFECT THE CHURCH'S RACIAL AND SOCIAL JUSTICE WORK?

Minister's Report: It has been a full month! Haley is working on a grant from the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation to help support the new Justice and Arts Ministry. She and Bridget will be working with Ruth & MaryAnn, our Communications Coordinators, to enhance that Ministry's social media presence. Bridget hosted a roundtable sponsored by Wisconsin Conservation Voters on the subject of tax credits for renewable energy. Osseo Middle School students were here Monday through Wednesday of this week. Much appreciation to Brad for setting up for both events. The Italo-American Association wishes to again use our space for its fall musical and potluck in October. Motion to again allow them to bring in and serve wine was approved (Betty/Sandy).

Clerk's Report

Treasurer's Report

Sandy distributed the May budget summary (attached). We are ahead of where we were last year so things look good. Motion to put on file approved (Jason/Jammie).

New Business

Continuing Business

• Generosity Team Update: The team did not meet this month. Its current focus is the fall pledge campaign.

- Review of the Church Rolls: Gail has drafted a letter which is in the process of being finalized. Group will be working on a meeting to review the rolls and to determine if there are folks who would be more appropriately reached by a personal contact instead of a letter.
- Bond of Union 125th Anniversary: Bridget is reaching out to a couple of folks for articles for Friday emails.
- WISE: Survey is complete. Friday email article is ready with links for the survey and will be sent out soon.
- <u>Capital Campaign</u>: Bridget noted that the funds reflected in the balance sheet are different from actual pledge income as the insurance proceeds from the fire were added to that balance because the lower-level work is part of the Capital Campaign. We have received \$507,000 of the \$572,000 pledged and our consultants say we are in good shape. Future quarterly giving statements will show the total amount of Capital Campaign dollars received in addition to the annual amount received so that donors know where they are relative to their total pledges.

STEWARDSHIP

Jason presented 3 motions from Stewardship for Capital Campaign expenditures, all of which were approved:

- 1. Up to \$5,000 to refinish the insides of the wood doors.
- 2. Up to \$5,000 for 2 area microphones and a new mixing board (including some re-wiring) which will better more effectively pick up the various components of the worship service.
- 3. Up to \$75,000 to remodel downstairs restrooms.

Bridget confirmed that we have sufficient Capital Campaign cash available for these projects.

Jason noted that the contractor handling the additional door openers for the exterior doors has recommended adding sensors so that the doors will not close on a person proceeding through the doorway, which will cause the spending on that project to exceed the approved amount by \$400. Common Ministry had no issue with Stewardship's decision to accept that recommendation.

The work remaining on the lower level is flooring and classroom partitioning. Stewardship is still investigating insurance alternatives.

Dan Hatton has agreed to take on the role of AV coordinator. He would welcome people to be added to the roster of folks to be trained.
