For Our Children and Youth

Our Faith Formation ministry grew to four classes and two youth groups. Through teaching, mentoring, and simply being present, volunteers helped create spaces where young people knew they were loved, welcomed, and encouraged to grow in faith.

For the Wider World

In January, 65 members gathered to prayerfully discern how our church is called to respond to the realities facing our immigrant neighbors, resulting in new ways to advocate for dignity, justice, and belonging.

For Our Community

Together with NEW Care, a Green Bay mutual aid organization, we co-hosted two *Really Free Markets*, where more than 100 volunteers helped serve over one thousand people. Together we shared food, clothing, household goods, and compassion - living out the belief that communities are strongest when we care for one another.

For Our Spiritual Lives

Week after week, people show up to make worship meaningful and welcoming - through music, hospitality, technology, leadership, and simple acts of kindness. From choir members to those who welcome new faces, each person helps create a space where people can encounter God in community.

For One Another

We show up for one another in quiet but powerful ways: delivering meals, checking in with a phone call or text, sitting beside one another in grief, and offering care through life's joys and struggles. These everyday acts of compassion are part of what makes our church a truly beloved community.
